Among other atomic bomb survivors, Matsushige Yoshito, who passed away in 2005, continuously tells his story at the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum.

Matsushige Yoshito was a 32 year old journalist who was at home at the time of the dropping of the atomic bomb in 1945. He survived at a distance of 2.7 kilometers from the bomb hypocenter.

'The Testimony of Hiroshima' describes the three hour lapse of time in Yoshito's life when he was unable to photograph death and pain.
