

JARIK JONGMAN Bio and CV

Jarik Jongman (Amsterdam, 1962) uses both his own photographs and anonymous pictures found in flea markets, books, magazines and the internet as a starting point for his work, which often deals with archetypical imagery. A painter and former assistant of Anselm Kiefer, Jongman's work in this show was originally intended as a study for a painting. Jarik Jongman studied in Arnhem and has had numerous exhibitions in London, Berlin, Switzerland, Amsterdam and in collateral events at the current 54th and at the 53rd (2009) Venice Biennale. In 2010 he won joint first prize for best artist at the National Open Art Competition, juried by Gavin Turk. He lives and works in London and Amsterdam and is represented by WW Gallery in the UK and Kap Pur Gallery in the Netherlands.
