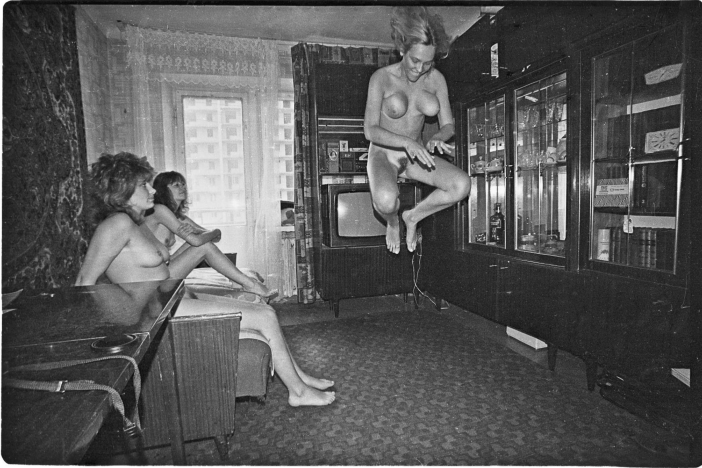


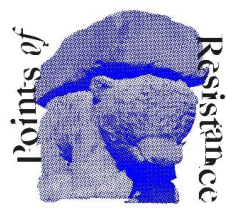
ROMAN PYATKOVKA

From 1979 to 1986 worked as the chief artist of lighting design at the Theater for Young Spectators (Kharkiv). In the early 1980s, he became interested in photography, and has been a member of the National Union of Photographic Artists of Ukraine since 1989.

He is active in teaching, both in Kharkiv and in other cities of Ukraine and abroad. Pyatkovka's works are in private and museum collections.
